Ken Williams has been President and CEO of Stone & Youngberg since 1996, when the firm became a limited liability company. Mr. Williams previously served on the Board of Directors of The Bond Market Association (now SIFMA) from 1995-98, and was Chairman of the Association's Municipal Securities Division in 1997. He was a member of the NASD (now FINRA) Fixed Income Committee from 1999-2001, and a member and Vice Chairman of the Board of Directors of the California Public Securities Association from 1986-88. He currently serves as an advisor to the University of the Pacific's Eberhardt School of Business Student Investment Fund. Mr. Williams is a member and past President of the Municipal Bond Club of San Francisco.
